DETENTION HOURS:

ATHLETICS:

Look for Athletic information to be posted in this space next week. This would include dropping off physicals, clearance forms and User Fee payments.

All 10th grade students are required by Massachusetts Law to have a current physical and, up to date immunization ON FILE in the nurse's office. If you aren't sure, make a copy and drop it by the school for the nurse to have. For example: If your child had a physical on July 21, 2007, the physical is good for 13 months, expiring on August 21, 2008. Please check the date on the physical paperwork, indicating the date of the visit and this will help you calculate.

Epi-pens and any medications a student might need to have at MHS during the school year, need to be brought to school at the beginning of the school year, along with the doctor orders and a MHS Medication Form.
